Function Keys

Turns the product on or off.

Backs up, erases a letter, or turns off the highlight at an entry.








Replacing Batteries

Your product is powered by two CR-2032 lithium, 3-volt batteries. Follow these easy instructions to replace them. Please have the new batteries at hand before you remove the old ones.

- 1. Turn the product off and turn it over.
- 2. Lift the battery cover on the back of your product by pushing up on the catch.
- 3. Remove the old batteries.
- 4. Install the batteries with the positive side up.
- 5. Replace the battery cover.

Warning: If the batteries wear-out completely, or if you take more than a few seconds while changing the batteries, any information that was entered in a card or built-in book may be erased. You should always keep written copies of your important information.

Changing the Language

Message Language

When your turn this product on for the first time, you must choose the message language. Press **A** for German or press **B** for English.

The message language is the language of prompts, help, and other messages. You can change the message language after your initial decision. See "Changing the Settings" to learn how.

Entry Language

The entry language is the language in which you enter words at the dictionary Word Entry screen. This determines which dictionary you will use, German or English. **Please Note:** The thesaurus is available for German words only.

- Press MENÜ.
- 2. Use the direction keys to highlight find and then press **EINGABE** to access the German-to-English dictionary.

Select at the icon menu to go to the English-to-German dictionary.
You can also touch **E/D** at the dictionary Word Entry screen to switch between German and English.

For Your Information

✓ Follow the Arrows

The flashing arrows on the right of the screen show which arrow keys you can press to move around menus or view more text.

✓ Help is Always at Hand

You can view a help message at any screen by pressing **HILFE**. Press **⊙** or **⊙** to read. To exit help, press **⊙**.

Using the Main Menu

When you press **MENÜ**, you will see ten icons. Use these to quickly take you to different parts of your dictionary. Use the arrow keys to highlight the icon you want and press **EINGABE**.

Viewing a Demonstration or Tutorial

- 1. Press MENÜ.
- 2. Use the arrow keys to highlight | Ta and press EINGABE.
- 3. Press ① to highlight either *Tutorial* or *View Demo* and press **EINGABE**.

To stop the demonstration or exit from the Tutorial and go to the dictionary Word Entry screen, press **CLEAR**.

To go to the main menu, press **MENÜ**.

When a book card is installed in your product, select *View Demo* from the Setup menu to see the demonstration for that card.

Changing the Settings

When using this dictionary, you can activate the *Learn a Word* feature, adjust the screen contrast, the shutoff time, the type size and the message language. The shutoff time is how long your product stays on if you forget to turn it off. *Learn a Word* helps you increase your vocabulary by displaying a different headword and definition each time you turn on your dictionary.

- 1. Press MENÜ.
- 2. Use the arrow keys to highlight \[\mathbb{T} \mathbb{Z} \] and press **EINGABE**.
- 3. Settings will be highlighted. Press EINGABE to select it.
- 4. Press ⊙ or ⊙ to move ▶ to Learn a Word, Contrast, Shutoff, Type Size or Anzeigesprache (Message Language).
- Press or or to change the setting.
 Your changes are automatically saved.
- Press EINGABE when done.
 Press CLEAR to return to the dictionary Word Entry screen.

Translating Words

Your dictionary is fully bilingual. To translate a German word into English, do the following.

- Press MENÜ, highlight Louis and press EINGABE.
- 2. Type a German word.

To erase a letter, press \bigcirc . **Note:** you do not need to type accents. To type accents if desired, type the letter (for example u) and press \bigcirc repeatedly until

the accent you want appears (for example \ddot{u}). To type ß, type s and press \odot . To type a capital, hold $\widehat{\odot}$ and press a letter key. To type a hyphen, hold **FN** and press **J**.

- 3. Press **EINGABE** to view the English definition.
 - Press \odot or \bigcirc to scroll.
- 4. Hold **FN** and press or to view the next or previous definition.
- 5. Press CLEAR when done.

To translate an English word into German, change the entry language from German to English.

✓ Understanding Definitions

Dictionary entries consist of headwords, pronunciation, parts of speech, and/or definitions. Other forms of the word may follow the headword. After the definition, you may see a list of usage examples.

✓ Explanation of Genders

German nouns are different from English nouns in that they must either be masculine, feminine, or neuter. Each definition of a noun indicates which gender it is with *m*, *f*, or *n*.

✓ Correcting Misspellings

If you enter a misspelled word, a list of corrections appears. Highlight the word you want and then press **EINGABE** to see its dictionary entry.

✓ Choosing Multiple Forms

Some words in this dictionary have more than one form (e.g. *resume*, *resumé*, *résumé*). When the word you are looking up has multiple forms, the different forms appear in a list. Simply highlight the form you want and press **EINGABE** to see its dictionary entry. For example, enter *resume* at the dictionary Word Entry screen. Highlight the form you want and press **EINGABE** to see its dictionary or thesaurus entry. To go back to the *Multiple Forms* list, press (2).

Using the Thesaurus

Note: The thesaurus is available for German words only. The headword appears in bold followed by the synonyms. If the word you type has more than one meaning, you will find several thesaurus entries for that word.

- Touch SYNON.
- 2. Type a German word (e.g., *frisch*).

 To erase a letter, press (a). To type a capital, hold (b) and press a letter key. To type a hyphen, hold **FN** and press **J**.
- 3. Press **EINGABE** to view the synonyms.
- 5. Hold **FN** and press ① or ① to view the next or previous thesaurus entry.
- Press CLEAR when done.

Finding Letters in Words

If you are uncertain about how to spell a word, type a question mark (?) in place of each unknown letter. To find prefixes, suffixes, and other parts of words, type an asterisk (*) in a word. Each asterisk stands for a series of letters.

Note: If you type an asterisk at the beginning of a word, it may take a little while to find the matching words.

- At a Word Entry screen, type a word with ?s and *s.
 To type an asterisk, hold ① and press ?.
- 2. Press EINGABE.

A list of words matching the pattern you entered appears.

- 3. Press 🕥 to move the highlight to the word you want and press **EINGABE** to view its definition or thesaurus entry.
- 4. Press CLEAR when done.

Highlighting Words

Another way to look up words is by highlighting them in dictionary entries, thesaurus entries or word lists. You can then find *their* definitions, thesaurus entries, or add them to *My Word List*.

- 1. At any text, press **EINGABE** to start the highlight. To turn the highlight off, press .
- 2. Use the arrow keys to move the highlight to the word you want.

Press CLEAR when done.

Using School Essentials

School Essentials gives you country information and helpful expressions. It allows you to test your spelling, improve your vocabulary, browse the TOEFL® Test Word List, and receive grammar guidance.

To access the School Essentials menu, press **MENÜ**, highlight **_____**, and press **EINGABE**, or you can just touch **LEARN**.

To select an item, use \odot to highlight your selection and press **EINGABE**.

Using the Grammar Guide

Your dictionary includes a helpful grammar guide that describes parts of speech. You can access this information in two ways.

From the School Essentials Menu

- Press MENÜ, highlight , and press EINGABE.
 Or you can touch LEARN.
- 2. Use 🕤 to highlight *Grammar Guide* and press **EINGABE**.
- 3. Press ① to highlight the topic you want to study and then press **EINGABE**.
- 4. Press or \bigcirc to read.
- 5. Press **FN** + ① or ② to view the next or previous topic.

From an Inflection Screen

- 1. Press **MENÜ**, highlight or GEET and then press **EINGABE**.
- 2. Type a word to conjugate and then touch **CONJ**.
- Press FN + ⊙ or ⊙ repeatedly to find the tense you want to read about in the Grammar Guide.
- Press HILFE.
 Information about the tense is displayed along with usage examples.
- 5. Press (a) to return to the inflection screen or press **CLEAR** to go to the dictionary Word Entry screen.

Advanced Verb Conjugations

Conjugations show inflections, or changes in a word's gender, tense, etc. This dictionary includes extensive inflections of nouns, verb, modifiers and other words.

From the Icon Menu

- 1. Press **MENÜ**, highlight (German conjugation) and then press **EINGABE**.
 - To choose English conjugation, select You can also touch **CONJ** and then touch **E/D** to choose the language.
- 2. Type a word (e.g., denken).
- Touch CONJ.

If needed, highlight the part of speech or translation you want and press **EINGABE**.

The English translations appear below each German inflection.

- 4. Press or \odot to scroll.
 - Press ?* to display the root word.
- 5. Touch either **CONJ** or hold **FN** and press ① repeatedly to view more inflections. If the word is a noun, an adjective, or another modifier, then there won't be any other inflections.
- 6. Press CLEAR when done.

From a Dictionary Entry

Some words have different parts of speech or multiple translations. You can easily find which part of speech or specific translation you will need to conjugate by first looking up the word and then touching **CONJ**. Follow this example.

1. Press **MENÜ**, use the arrow keys to highlight **Levil** and then press **EINGABE**.

To choose English, select You can also touch **CONJ** and then **E/D** to choose the language.

- 2. Type a word (e.g., reden).
- Choose a form, if needed.
 In this case, choose reden. Capitalized words are usually nouns.
- Press EINGABE to look it up.
 Read the definition to find the verb you want (e.g., to talk).
- 5. Touch **CONJ** to conjugate the headword, *reden*.

Highlight the translation you want (e.g., *talk*) and press **EINGABE**. The principal forms of the German verb "reden" are listed. The English translations are below each German inflection.

- Press or or oto scroll.
 Press ?* to display the root word.
- 7. Touch either **CONJ** or hold **FN** and press **(Continuo)** repeatedly to view more inflections. If the word is a noun, an adjective, or another modifier, then there won't be any other inflections.
- 8. Press CLEAR when done.

✓ Accenting Letters

You can look up accented words without typing accents. If there are no Multiple Forms, the *German/English Dictionary* will take you directly to the word. If there are Multiple Forms, you will have to choose the correct word from a *Multiple Forms* list. See "Choosing Multiple Forms" for more information.

Remember, if you want to enter an accent yourself, type the letter and press \odot until the appropriate accent appears.

✓ Getting Grammar Guidance

When viewing inflections, you can press **HILFE** to go directly to the Grammar Guide and view detailed descriptions of how to use the inflections you were viewing along with usage examples.

✓ Viewing English Inflections

If you are unfamiliar with inflections, it may be helpful to look at some inflected forms of English verbs. Switch the entry language back to English, enter *write* and touch **CONJ** to see the different forms of the English verb "to write".

This will give you a good idea of each inflection form.

✓ Verb Conjugations

The *German/English Dictionary* conjugates German verbs into the following forms: present, preterite, future, present subjunctive, future subjunctive, preterite subjunctive, present conditional, imperative, present participle, past participle, perfect indicative, pluperfect indicative, future perfect, perfect subjunctive, pluperfect subjunctive, future perfect subjunctive, and past conditional.

Translating Traveller's Phrases

There are two ways in which you can translate several helpful phrases in categories ranging from Emergencies to Business Communication to Time & Dates.

Browsing Through Phrases

- Press MENÜ.
- 2. Highlight and then press **EINGABE** to view the English phrases.

Press to view the German phrases.

You can also hold **FN** and press **?** to go straight to the Phrases menu in the same language as the lookup language.

- 3. Press ⊙ or ⊙ to highlight the category you want and press **EINGABE**. Press ⊙ or ⊙ to highlight a subcategory, if needed and press **EINGABE**.
- Press ⊙ or ⊙ to highlight the phrase you want to translate and then press EINGABE.

Searching for a Specific Phrase

- 1. Press **CLEAR** and touch **E/D** to select the lookup language, if needed.
- 2. Type a keyword for which you'd like to find a phrase (e.g., ticket).
- 3. Hold **FN** and press ?.
- 4. If more than one phrase is found, press ① to scroll.

Using My Word List

You can save up to 40 words total, in both English and German, in My Word List for personal study or review. *My Word List* is saved between sessions unless your product is reset.

Adding Words from the Main Menu

- Press MENÜ, highlight and press EINGABE.
 Or you can touch LEARN, and then press EINGABE.
- 2. Touch **E/D** to switch from the English to the German List, if needed.
- 3. Press 🕙 or 🕤 to highlight Add a Word and press EINGABE.
- 4. Type a word.
- Press EINGABE to add the word.
- Press CLEAR when done.

Adding Words from the Dictionary Word Entry Screen

You can also add words to *My Word List* directly from the Word Entry screen. Since many German words are compounds from two or more words, you will have to add each component separately to your word list.

- Press CLEAR.
- 2. Touch **E/D** to choose the language of the word you want to add.
- 3. Type the word you want to add to your word list.

- 4. Touch **LEARN**.
 - Your selection is included in the menu item.
- 5. Press **EINGABE** to add the word.
- 6. Press **CLEAR** to return to the dictionary Word Entry screen.

✓ Adding Highlighted Words

You can also add words to *My Word List* from definitions and correction lists. First highlight a word and then touch **LEARN**. *Add "your word"* will be highlighted. Press **EINGABE** to add the word.

Viewing My Word List

- 1. Press **MENÜ**, highlight and press **EINGABE**.
- 2. Touch **E/D** to switch to the English or German list, if needed.
 - ...list: Empty will be displayed if the list is empty.
- 3. English List (or German List) will be highlighted.
- Press EINGABE to view the list.

Removing a Word from My Word List

In the My Word List menu, select Delete a Word. Highlight the word you want to delete and press **EINGABE**.

Erasing My Word List

In the *My Word List* menu, first select the list you want to delete then select *Erase the List*. Press **Y** to erase the list or press **N** to cancel. **Note:** When you erase one list the other list is not erased.

Playing The Games

You have seven fun games to choose from: Hangman, Conjumania, Gender Tutor, Word Train, Guess That Word, Word Auction, and Word Blaster.

Changing Game Settings

Before you play, you can choose the source and size of the words, the skill level, the language, and whether or not graphics will be used.

- 1. Press MENÜ, highlight , and press EINGABE.
- 2. Hold ① and press ① to highlight Game Settings and press EINGABE.
- 3. Use ⊙ or ⊙ to move ▶ to Words, Skill, Lang or Graphics.

 Words chooses the source of the words: All of them, TOEFL® List, My Word List, or Enter your own.

Note: Not all of the options are available for every game.

Skill determines how easy or difficult a game is.

When you use words from your personal list, words you miss are repeated more often to help you learn them.

- 4. Use ① or ② to change the setting you want.
- 5. Press **EINGABE** when done.

Selecting a Game

In the Games list, use \odot or \odot to move the highlight to the game of your choice and press **EINGABE**.

Getting Help in the Games

During any game you can read instructions by pressing HILFE.

You can get a hint by holding ① and pressing ? or reveal the game word by pressing ?.

Note: If you reveal the game word, you lose the round.

Using the Clock

The Clock displays the current time and date. You can save two times: Home time and World time.

- 1. Press .
- 2. Touch **CLOCK** to toggle between Home time and World time.
- 3. From Home time, press **EINGABE** to set the time and date.
- 4. Use \odot and \odot to scroll through the options in the highlighted field.
- 5. Use (•) and (•) to move to another field.

- Press EINGABE when done.Press CLEAR to exit without saving the settings.
- 7. Touch **CLOCK** to toggle to World time.
- 8. Set World time the same way you set Home time.

Using the Databank

Adding Entries

You can store as many as 100 names and telephone numbers and addresses in the Databank. The total number of names you can add depends on the size of each entry.

- 1. Press and touch **DATA**.
- 2. Highlight Add an Entry and then press EINGABE.
- 3. Type a name and press EINGABE.
- 4. Type a phone number and press EINGABE.

Note: **Q-P** will type numbers **0-9** automatically To type a letter from this row, hold **FN** and press the letter key. To type a hyphen, hold **FN** and press **J**.

- Type a postal address or e-mail address and press EINGABE.
 To type an @, hold FN and press M.
- 6. Press **MENÜ** to go to the dictionary.

Viewing or Editing Entries

- 1. Press and touch **DATA**.
- 2. Highlight View: XX entries (XX% free) and then press **EINGABE**.
- 3. To edit an entry, highlight it and press **EINGABE**. Type your changes. Use ① to move the cursor; use ② to delete.
- Press EINGABE to move to the number field.
 Press EINGABE twice to move to the address field.
- 5. Press **EINGABE** again to save your changes or hold down **FN** and press to cancel your changes.
- 6. Press MENÜ to go to the dictionary.

Deleting Entries

- 1. Press and touch **DATA**.
- 2. Highlight Delete an Entry and then press EINGABE.
- 3. Highlight the entry you want to delete and press **EINGABE**.
- To delete all databank entries, highlight Erase the List in the Databank Menu and then press EINGABE.

Press Y to erase all databank entries or N to cancel the deletion.

5. Press **MENÜ** to go to the dictionary.

Using a Password

You can use a password to prevent unauthorized access to the Databank. **Warning!** Always write the password in a safe, separate location. If you lose or forget the password, you will be able to use the Databank again only by removing the batteries from your BOOKMAN device, which will permanently erase all the information stored in the Databank.

- 1. Press and touch **DATA**.
- 2. Highlight Set password and then press **EINGABE**.
- 3. Type a password of up to eight characters and press **EINGABE**. Use ① to move the cursor; use ② to delete.
- Press C to confirm or CLEAR to cancel the password.
 The password you set will be requested the first time the Databank is used during a session.
- To change the password, repeat Steps 1-5.To remove a password, press EINGABE at the blank password screen.
- 6. Press **MENÜ** to go to the dictionary.

Using the Calculator

- 1. Press and touch CALC.
- 2. Type a number.

Note: **Q-P** will type numbers **0-9** automatically. You can type up to 10 digits. To type a decimal, press **G** (.). To change the sign of a number, press **Y** (+/-).

- 3. Press a math function key.
- 4. Type another number.
- 5. Press EINGABE.

To repeat the calculation, press **EINGABE** again.

To Calculate	Press
reciprocals	FN+A
squares	FN+D
percentages	FN+F
square roots	FN+S
negative numbers	FN+Z

- 6. Press CLEAR to clear the current calculations.
- 7. Press **MENÜ** to go to the dictionary.

Using the Calculator Memory

- 1. In the Calculator, make a calculation or type a number.
- To add the number on the screen to the number stored in memory, press X (M+). To subtract the number on the screen from the number stored in memory, press C (M-).
 M indicates the number is stored in memory.
- 3. To retrieve the number from memory, press V (MR).
- 4. To clear the memory, press **B** (MC).

Using the Metric Converter

- 1. Press and touch CONV.
- 2. Use 🕤 to select a conversion category (e.g., Weights).
- 3. Select a conversion (e.g., grams/ounces).
- 4. Type a number after one of the units.

Note: **Q-P** will type numbers **0-9** automatically. Press ⊙ or ⊙ to move between the lines. Press ⊕ to delete a number.

- 5. Press **EINGABE** to convert it.
- 6. Press CLEAR to clear the current conversion.
- 7. Press **MENÜ** to go to the dictionary.

Using the Currency Converter

- Press and touch CURR.
- 2. Enter a conversion rate.

The rate should be in units of the other currency per one unit of the home currency (n other/1 home).

- Enter an amount for the home or other currency.
 Press ⊙ or ⊙ to move between the lines. Use ☺ to delete a number.
- 4. Press **EINGABE** to convert it.
- 5. Press **CLEAR** to clear the current conversion.
- 6. Press **MENÜ** to go to the dictionary.

Resetting Your Product

If the keyboard fails to respond, or if the screen performs erratically, perform a system reset by following the steps below.

- 1. Hold **CLEAR** and press **(b)**. If nothing happens, try Step 2.
- Use a paper clip to gently press the reset button on your unit.The reset button is recessed in a pin-sized hole to the left of the card slot.

Warning! Pressing the reset button with more than light pressure may permanently disable your product. In addition, resetting product erases settings and information entered in its built-in book, and in an installed card.
